Information

- Students must reach class age by September 1, 2010.
- The registration fee is due by **February 15th** to confirm your child's enrollment. Half the first month's tuition is due by **April 1st**.
- St. Peter's Lutheran Church members and families with two or more students enrolled will receive a 10% tuition discount on the second child.
- The fees are NON-REFUNDABLE unless you move from the Marble Falls area before August 1, 2010.

*St. Peter's School offers a KINDERGARTEN SCHOLARSHIP that pays half of the monthly tuition. Additional tuition assistance may be obtainable to students based upon need and funds available. Applications may be obtained by contacting the director.
